

**The Dorothy Van Eck Scholarship Awards**  
**Description and Selection Procedure**  
**Two \$ 1,300 scholarships available for 2008–09**

1. The applicant must be a full-time art student who plans to attend Northwestern College during his/her sophomore, junior or senior year on a full-time basis as a declared art major.
2. To be eligible for the award, the applicant must have a 2.7 or higher cumulative grade point average and 3.0 in the major.
3. The award should be made in consideration of, but not limited to, the applicant's financial need.
4. The award will be made for one academic year.
5. The **deadline is March 15 by 5 p.m.**,
6. The award will begin with the fall semester of 2008.

**To Apply**

1. The applicant must provide evidence of outstanding potential for further development in the visual arts by means of a portfolio of digital photographs on a CD. The portfolio must include at least 10 and up to 20 works displaying a range of media, both two- and three-dimensional. All works included must have been executed as part of coursework at Northwestern College.
2. The applicant should show evidence of their Christian faith and character by writing a statement at least one-half page in length describing from the applicant's point of view regarding how the contemporary Christian integrates his or her faith with work as an artist/student. The statement must be typed and single-spaced.
3. The applicant should submit a typed application sheet with the following information along with the portfolio CD and statement:

Northwestern College address

Phone/e-mail address

Cumulative GPA

List of courses taken at Northwestern College

Numbered list of artworks included in the portfolio, with descriptions if they are not included with the images on the CD

Descriptions should include the medium, technique and any other information that would help to understand the work.

Deliver the statement, application sheet and your name with your portfolio CD by the deadline to Rein Vanderhill, department chair. The art department faculty will notify you of the results after March 20, 2008.
