Northwestern offers several \$1,000 James L. Franken Servant Leadership Scholarships. The scholarships are available to incoming freshman students with outstanding leadership abilities and a desire to grow in those abilities while a student at Northwestern.

To be eligible for this scholarship, applicants must meet either (or both) of these criteria:

- a minimum high school GPA of 3.25 and an ACT score (or SAT equivalent) of 23 or above and/or
- graduation from any local or worldwide CAPS Network program  capsnetwork
collaborate · innovate · educate

To apply, email the following documents to Kendall Stanislav (kendall.stanislav@nwciova.edu), director of Experiential Education at Northwestern College:

- This completed application form
- A one-page essay reflecting on at least one of the core values of James L. Franken and the Interstates Companies where he served as president/CEO: servant leadership, dependability, integrity, trust, quality or family. Identify why you selected the particular value and how it relates to you.
- A letter of recommendation from one of your high school teachers

If you are chosen to receive a Franken Servant Leadership Scholarship, you will enroll in the 4-credit leadership course during one of your first four semesters. This leadership course fulfills one of the college's NWCore Requirements.
