## **STEP 3 | TESTING APPOINTMENT**

To access testing at Orange City Area Health System **select** *additional scheduling options* or *I'd like to be tested at a local clinic*. Test lowa will provide you with a **QR Code** that will be required at the testing location, and an email with the participant unique access code number. The QR code is valid at any Test lowa site. (Options shown on next page.)

The following locations are part of the Testlowa.com process:

Select this option to receive a QR code to use at a local clinic. You will be required to call the clinic to schedule an appointment.

## STEP 4 | TESTING

You will be tested at OCAHS/Occupational Health (location listed above) and should bring the **QR code** provided from the Health Assessment (either a printed copy or via the confirmation email on your smart phone).

### **STEP 5 | TEST RESULTS**

Once the Lab Processing is complete and a result reported, you will be notified via email to view the results in the Patient Portal using a unique access code you received when the test was scheduled. This code is unique to you and will allow you to track the testing process. Results will not be sent directly to you—you need to login to the Patient Portal. Please store the access code in a safe place for future reference. Test results will be received in about 72 hours.

## **Rapid Tests and Weekend Testing**

Rapid tests are available for faculty, staff and students but are limited to persons who are exhibiting symptoms. You will need to make an appointment with the main clinic to see a doctor. Orange City's Area Health System's Walk In Clinic may offer rapid tests if they have adequate testing supplies. Both clinics will bill insurance for the doctor's visit and testing. Weekend hours are available (see below).
